

Stratford PTSA General Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Kim Selzman, President, at 7:07 p.m. and it was determined that a quorum was present.

The minutes from the March 30, 2016 general meeting were presented. A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of March 30, 2016 meeting.

Ms. Bradshaw presented the treasurer report. Income raised to date is \$108,462.34. Expenses to date are: 76,789.73. The following budget amendments were approved: Increase scholarship income and expenses by \$9,000. This will give student scholarships \$31,500.00. Increase teacher scholarship expenses by \$4,000, decrease Special Project expenses by \$2,000, decrease staff resources by \$2000 . This will give teacher scholarships a total of \$6,000. A motion was passed and seconded to accept the budget amendments.

Ms. Selzman thanked the 2015-16 PTSA officers for their service this past school year. The Board consisted of 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President - Scholarships Alison White, 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President - Membership Anna Farris, 3<sup>rd</sup> Vice President - Directory Diana Bates, Treasurer Jennifer Bradshaw, Secretary Myra Lewis, Historian Beth Cole and Parliamentarian Debbie Slack.

Ms. Slack conducted the installation ceremony for the PTSA officers for 2016-17. The incoming officers are President Kim Selzman, 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President - Scholarships Karen Alexander, 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President - Membership Anna Farris, 3<sup>rd</sup> Vice President - Directory Diana Bates, Treasurer Cindy McGinty, Secretary Brandy Demeris, Historian Beth Cole and Parliamentarian Carrie Goolsby.

Ms. Farris announced PTA Life Memberships awarded on behalf of the PTSA. PTA Life Memberships were awarded to Gene Rutland, Laura Yonkin, Robin Udstuen, Amy Watkins, Dianne Fishman, and SHS Senior Class President, Scott Kennedy.

Ms. White announced PTSA teacher scholarships. Six \$1,000 teacher scholarships were awarded to Davy Barrett, Vickie Bucio, Mary Jackson, Buffie Mathews, Kristy Schaper, and Elaine Sorsby.

Ms. Selzman noted that besides parents and teachers, students can join PTSA.
